General Information

- Quiet time 11pm
- There is **no life guard on duty at the swimming pool**. The deepest pool area is 5 feet at the south end.
- A number of individual Park users who have keys to the entrance gate may use the Park at any time. When the Park facilities, listed under **Fees** below, have been booked by other individuals or organizations, Key Holders are to be courteous to the individuals or organizations who have rented the facilities and are to stay away from the area or facilities that are rented.
- Warman RCMP have access to the Park at all times and may check the Park periodically. (306-975-1670)
- Please help preserve the Park as a safe and peaceful facility. Report rowdiness, vandalism, or unauthorized access to the booking agent. Vehicle descriptions, license numbers, descriptions of persons and any other detailed information will be helpful. If there is suspicion of unauthorized access, a Park Board Director may ask a Park User to identify themselves by asking for their name and key number, which they must provide upon request.
- In case of an emergency at the Park, please call 911.
- Power generators are prohibited from being used within the park. Please use inverter generators if requiring extra power for camping.

Additional fees apply for use of the Park by a group, which includes use of Park buildings and certain other facilities. These must be booked in advance.

Prorated Rental Information

Prorated fees are based on the approximate amount of people that will be attending your group event within the Park for the period of your rental.

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| • Approx. 150 people or less | \$425.00 per day |
| • Approx. 200 people | \$525.00 per day |
| • Approx. 250 people | \$600.00 per day |
| • Approx. 300 people | \$800.00 per day |
| • Approx. 400 people | \$1,000.00 per day |
| • Approx. 500+ people | \$1,300.00 per day |

- Overnight camping (electrified) \$20.00 per day for each

- Overnight camping (non-electrified) \$10.00 per day (tenting)

The above fees are subject to change, upon review of the Park Board members.

- Special rates are available for Schools and Ukrainian Catholic Organizations. Ask your booking agent for details.
- Special requests can be negotiated with the booking agent and may incur additional fees.
- **Fees and facilities are subject to change for bookings made 6 months or more in advance.** Should there be a change in fees or facilities available, you will be advised and will have the option of canceling your booking.
- **A non-refundable deposit** (with exception of the Park canceling your booking) will be required **3 months** in advance of your booked date.

Park Rules

- Every user of the Park is subject to all of the rules of the Park.

Vehicles (including all-terrain vehicles, motorcycles and all other motorized vehicles)

- are not to be operated on playgrounds, campsites, baseball diamonds or picnic sites.
- are not to be parked on roadways.
- will observe a maximum speed limit of 15 km/hr at all times, in all areas of the Park.

Laws Governing Public Places Apply

- The Park is deemed to be a public place. All federal, provincial and municipal laws, statutes, and regulations pertaining to public places are in force on Park property. Therefore **Saskatchewan liquor laws and regulations apply**. It is the responsibility of the users of the Park to obtain liquor permits for all rentals.
- Persons found tampering with Park property in any way, shape or form, will be held accountable for their actions. They will be responsible for all costs associated caused by their actions, for all repairs needed to the Park property. Both Key Holders and renters and or guests will be banned from the Park immediately. Key Holders will have their key removed from them. All persons banned will have to appear in front of the Park Board to re-gain access to the park for future visits.

Preservation of Environment / Pet Control

- Live trees and shrubs are not to be cut down or disturbed without consent of the booking agent.
- Dead-fall may be collected for use as firewood.
- Animals and birds are not to be hunted, trapped, stalked or disturbed without consent of the booking agent.
- Firearms, air-guns, spring operated guns, traps as well as any other hunting or trapping apparatus, are strictly prohibited within the Park without the consent of the booking agent.
- Dumping of sewage or waste water in the Park is prohibited.
- Pets are allowed in the park subject to the following restrictions and provisions:
 - Dogs are to be leashed at all times and in all areas of the Park
 - No pets of any kind are allowed in the swimming pool
 - All pet excrement must be immediately removed (may be deposited in the Park garbage containers).

Leaving the Park in Good Order

Checkout time is 11:00 am on the last day of rental.

Upon leaving the Park:

- All open fires are to be completely extinguished, including briquettes in barbeques.
- All buildings, including washrooms, are to be left clean. Floors are to be swept and washed. Lights and water taps must be turned off. Doors are to be locked.
- Other facilities, including propane barbeque, camping and picnic sites, and the grounds generally are to be left clean and tidy. Garbage is to be placed in Park garbage containers.
- All vehicles, campers, trailers, tents and any other kind of equipment must be removed.

- The Park entrance gate is to be locked at all times and all keys for rentals of the Park, must be returned to the booking agent.
- If the Park or its amenities are not left in good order, renters and or Key Holders are responsible for any extra fees needed to bring it back to its proper state. This includes but is not limited to (repairs to damaged property, garbage removal, cleaning campsites, cleaning bathrooms, etc.) Please remember to clean up your mess.

Fireworks

The use of fireworks is permitted within the Park. The only area designated for the use of fireworks is the ball diamond area.

- Fireworks are not permitted if Corman Park has issued a fire ban. The person(s) found using fireworks in the duration of a fire ban will be responsible and liable for all consequences and costs that arise if a fire or any damage is caused to the Park, due to the fireworks.
- Fireworks shall be used by a responsible, competent person and shall be used in a safe manor to not harm the park or its occupants.
- If you choose to use fireworks within the Park you are responsible for the cleanup of the debris left behind from them.
- Anyone planning on using fireworks within the Park for any event, please contact the booking agent and let them know you will be doing so.

Membership Information

A new membership policy was set in 2014. Fee structures are subject to periodic review. **The new fees will apply to all current Key Holders at the expiry of their terms.**

Key Holder Personal Access Privileges to the Park

Key Holders are issued keys to the Park gate for day use of the grounds with family and friends, approximately 10 people. **Overnight family camping is permitted only at the discretion of the booking agent** at a rate of \$20.00 per night (electrified site) for each camping unit (RV, motorhome, trailer, tent) and a rate of \$10.00 per day (non-electrified locations)(tenting). The Park retains the right to grant and revoke these privileges at its discretion. The fees for personal Park access are as follows:

Park Membership and Key Holder access privileges combined - \$50.00 per year

Non-Members - \$75.00 per year

Initial Key - \$15.00 (refundable)

Replacement Key - \$25.00 (Non-refundable)

Park Membership Only – No Access Privileges \$20.00

A Park member **must be a member of the Eparchy of Saskatoon** through affiliation with a Ukrainian Catholic Parish in Saskatchewan. A member is entitled to vote at the Annual General Meeting of St. Volodymyr Ukrainian Catholic Park Inc.

Tax Status and Fees
